

ABOUT NUMBER 43 - 2022

The Number 43 Trelawney Park kwaMagogo Legacy Project is a product of a very successful publication of the same title, in 2007. The Legacy Project primarily gives ownership to the total liberation of the continent, affords a platform to recognise and provide knowledge on the contribution of the peoples of the Southern African region and the world.

Number 43 Trelawney Park is a house situated in Swaziland that has strong links to South Africa's struggle history for freedom. The house is rich in history and heritage both in a political sense as well as a portrait of a South African family in a postcolonial Swaziland. The Number 43 Trelawney Park Legacy Project is initiated and run by the Number 43 Trelawney Park kwaMagogo Foundation.

At the heart of this Momentous Celebration is the inherent obligation to recognise those who led the way, took up the spear and blazed the path to today's South Africa - **Amahlahandlela**. This is an isiZulu word, meaning pioneers. There is no doubt that this celebration reaches and touches everyone both in the region and beyond. We have no doubt that you would want to be a part of it.

This pioneering spirit, drove people, including the architects of Number 43, more than fifty years ago – namely, uButhongo and uMakgomo Masilela, when they left South Africa protesting against Bantu Education and settled at Number 43. As history would have it, their relocation from South Africa would provide an important and strategic outpost for the liberation movement against the sinister apartheid regime.

2022 PLANNED ACTIVITIES

Friday, 17 June 2022

- **Business Breakfast Roundtable (07h30 to 09h30)**
Venue: Royal Villas

Over the years, the Legacy Event has grown in stature. It has focused its attention on both economic and social issues. The participants are significant corporate leaders and policy makers

from around the world. It has become imperative that we incorporate an activity that will allow these participants an opportunity to engage on common interests that will allow a coordination for the growth of the region and partnerships with the rest of the world.

Delphine Govender, will be the agitator of this gathering, by leading the Roundtable on key issues facing South Africa, Swaziland and the region. The breakfast will be facilitated by Victor Kgomoewana.

The contribution to this event is **R300**.

- **Annual Charity Legacy Golf Day (10h30 to 17h30)**
Venue: Royal Swazi Hotel and Spa (Ezulwini Golf & Country Club)

Tee off will be at 10.30am ending with a prize-giving cocktail at 16h30.

Early bird Entry Fee will be **R1, 500** per player for the first ten fourballs, **R2,000** per player for the rest. This will include Green Fees, Prize-giving cocktail and Complimentary Golf Shirt and Cap. We are targeting a 120 field (30 fourballs), so space is limited.

To sponsor a hole it is **R15,000**.

Golfers intending to participate should submit their golf shirt sizes on registration, failing which the organisers will estimate. Further, you are encouraged to donate your used t-shirt, to charity.

- **Magogo Walk (11h00 to 13h30)**
Venue: Number 43, Trelawney Park

For the Non-golfers, there is an opportunity to enjoy a tour of the House, Number 43 kwaMagogo, and journey into the past. This is followed by a drive to Magogo's grave to lay flowers. We will depart the hotel(s), soon after the breakfast and assemble at Number 43 for the tour.

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| Saturday, 18 June 2022 |
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- **Number 43 10km Legacy Walk & Run (06h30)**
Venue: Number 43, Trelawney Park

In the morning of 18 June at 6.30am, we will kick off with a 10&21km walk/run, around Manzini. Traditionally, this event will cover critical historical sites. It will start off at Number 43 and end at the Pendray Park. There are medals for everyone finishing within one hour of the start – gold, silver and bronze. The race is professionally managed by Golden Foot Club, of Manzini.

The registration fee for the race will be **R150 for the 10km and R200 for the 21km distance** per person. Register by the 17th of June. Late registration will attract an additional **R50**.

- **Magogoism & Memorial Run (09h30 to 14h00)**
Venue: Number 43, Trelawney Park

The highlight of the events over the Legacy weekend will be Magogoism. The Masilela family and sponsors will be feeding the community, giving out food hampers and blankets to **43 indigent families**, at the grounds of Number 43. The event extends the spirit passed on to us by uMagogo, that of giving and sharing – selflessly, now known as “Magogoism”.

Parallel to this will a First, for the Legacy Event, where we will be hosting a Number 43 Bikers' Memorial Run. This will be to celebrate and honour the memory of fallen bikers. You are invited to participate in the inaugural Number 43 Memorial Run. The Run will start at Number 43 Trelawney Park, KwaMagogo and follow the Magogo Route, run past Number 43 to sites along the road, proceed to Oshoek and back to Number 43. The Run to Oshoek is significant in the liberation relationship history between the two countries. Families of the fallen and bikers will be Awarded with Badges of Honour.

There is no cost for these activities. It is the heart of the Legacy Event.

- Annual Legacy Lecture and Gala Dinner (18h30)

Venue: Royal Villas

(Wear something yellow – Ndebele yellow!)

This event attracts much sought out speakers from both sides of the border, in a very Royal setting, enjoying a backdrop of the magnificent Mdzimba Mountains. **This year we have a panel of Awardees and Speakers, in alphabetical order:**
